Rules and Regulations

- 1. Three age groups A(18-35), B(36-50) and C(51 and Over) in each of the four styles. All divisions are unisex and levels are merged bronze through gold (Not restricted to syllabus figures).
- 2. You have to enter the same age in all events through out the year and you can only enter in one age.
- 3. The student can only represent one age and one style in November 2024.
- 4. The teacher can be represented more than once.
- 5. Points will be based on accumulation of callbacks and placements earned through out the 2024 series events starting with the 2023 OSB and team representation will be decided at the conclusion of the last series event prior to the 2024 OSB.

BEST OF BEST ENTRY FORM

Bronze and Silver Best of Best solos must be danced on Tuesday evening and Gold on Wednesday evening. Each student can only enter once. Each solo will receive a placement. Although there may be several first places presented, only the person with the top score in the division will represent their category at the Ohio Star Ball Best of Best. Only the winners chosen at the Millennium will represent the Showdance, Showcase and Theatre Art divisions in Ohio. All routines are limited to 2 1/2 minutes and Showdance and Showcase are limited to 3 lifts.

The time limit for Showdance and Showcase at Ohio Star Ball is 1 1/2 minutes.
